General Responsibilities:

Design and teach a curriculum for each age group, ensuring the highest standards of safety and teaching. The Climbing Instructor will ensure that all other climbing staff are appropriately trained and operate within the program guidelines. The Climbing instructor will provide a fun and safe environment for Campers to acquire/ develop climbing skills

Specific Duties:

- Design a curriculum to be followed during Seatrades
- Set up and inspect all climbing gear, anchors, and climbing terrain daily
- Retire and replace any equipment which shows signs of damage, wear, or has reached the end of its life
- Supervise instruction during all climbing periods
- Train all other climbing staff in safety procedures and teaching curriculum
- Assist with special program events as needed

The Climbing Instructor will actively pursue the ministry of the camp through the application of Biblical principles in his/her leadership of and personal relationships with the staff and campers
