General Responsibilities:

Leading and planning Adventure Camp programs with the Mountain Bike Camp Director including, providing spiritual direction, skills training, and ensuring all activities, instruction, and facilities meet BCCA Accreditation standards. Through the maintenance of boats and wakeboard equipment, the adherence to all Transport Canada rules regarding the use of boats, the instruction and discipline of campers and jr staff. The overarching goal is one of safety for all participants in the Wakeboard program.

Specific Duties:

- Making schedule
- Ensure quality of programs and instruction in Wakeboard Camp
- Leading one day trip each week
- Plan and lead daily staff meetings with Adventure Camp staff, coordinating with Mountain Bike Camp Director
- Attend weekly senior staff meetings
- Plan teachings and/or speakers for age groups that are different from main camp campers
- Meet weekly with Adventure Camp Skippers individually to provide support and encouragement
- Discipline campers and Adventure Camp staff when needed
- Log boat & equipment use

The Wakeboard Camp Director will actively pursue the ministry of the camp through the application of Biblical principles in his/her leadership of and personal relationships with the staff and campers
